SCOPE OF SERVICES: The Contractor shall provide Yearbook Services for Middle and High Schools as set forth in the Contract Documents.

COMPENSATION: The Owner will pay and the Contractor will accept in full consideration for the performance during the contract term the fees and pricing as outlined in their proposal response and updated/attached hereto.

CONTRACT PERIOD: May 17, 2017 through May 17, 2020, with three (3) additional one-year renewal terms as mutually agreed upon by both parties; Contractor understands and agrees to the Owner school's right to select their Yearbook Services Contractor each school year.

- (2) RFP 52-17sm dated February 23, 2017 and Addendum # 1 dated March 13, 2017;
- (3) The Contractor's proposal dated March 23, 2017, all of which documents are incorporated herein.

Workshops and Training

As a part of this RFP, Middle School advisers are welcome to attend YearbookNV at no cost. Also, Kara offers a workshop exclusive to middle school students and advisers in October. The adviser and up to five students may attend the one-day workshop at no cost; additional students are \$25/each.

Yearbook Sales and Marketing

Schools will partner with the Yearbook Order Center to record and to track yearbook and/or ad sales. The sales tracking software eBusiness can accommodate any combination of in-school and YOC sales. Herff Jones will mail one Sales Assist Postcard home to parents. The local representative will design paper order forms for the schools, set up the school in eBusiness and eShare and provide training for Send and Sell. If parent email addresses are available, the school can take advantage of the Parent Engagement Series.

Production Schedule

The school can negotiate one, two or three submission deadlines with the local representative. All submission deadlines are Mondays. Because flat and/or signature completion is not required, a page is a page, so a school can submit any combination of pages on any deadline. A successful 4/9 final deadline will allow for a 5/12 ship date, which is a five-week turnaround.

Workshops and Training

As a part of this RFP, High School advisers are welcome to attend YearbookNV **OR** Herff Jones' Signature Camp at William & Mary at no cost. Kara also offers a one-day fall workshop in October. Each school may send the adviser and up to five students to the one-day workshop at no cost; additional students are \$25/each.

All school levels: Custom, Owner school-designed covers are included at no cost. Owner schools may chose a company-designed cover, if desired.

High Schools and Middle Schools: Four-color litho cover with gloss lamination **OR** a silkscreen cover with choice of one standard base material, one silkscreen ink, one standard foil plus one grain. Custom dies are additional and cost is dependent upon complexity. For example, a text-only die is \$150-\$200. Schools will approve cost of die prior to production.

In addition, common cover enhancements include the following:

- Soft and matte lamination \$.77/copy
- Spot UV lamination \$75 setup + \$.75/copy
- Additional silkscreen ink \$1.12/copy
- Quarterbound cover \$1.28/copy
- Custom embossing with a litho application \$525/order plus die charge

• End sheet stock

High Schools: Choice of vibracolor endsheet stock is included; uncoated endsheet stocks are available and range from \$.30/copy to \$1.18/copy.

In addition, common endsheet enhancements include the following:

- Printed in black ink only \$266.06
- Additional litho ink \$226.06 per color
- Spot UV lamination \$75 setup + \$.75/copy

Middle Schools: Choice of vibracolor endsheet stock is included; choice of uncoated Signature endsheet stocks are available for \$.30/copy. Company-designed endsheets to coordinate with company-designed covers are \$.65/copy.

• Alteration charges; as noted in 3.1.4 via corrections and changes

High Schools and Middle Schools: Changes to cover and endsheet proofs are considered Creative Art Services and are charged at \$55/hour. Changes to pages after submission, but before printing and plating, are subject to a \$27.50/page release fee.

High Schools: Up to 20 overruns provided by plant; if unnecessary, may be returned for credit

Middle Schools: Up to 20 overruns provided by plant; if unnecessary, may be returned for credit

High School and Middle School yearbooks will ship from the Kansas City, KS printing facility on Old Dominion Freight Line. Schools will be notified the afternoon the books ship via email. The next morning, schools will receive a tracking number. Books will deliver on the third day after shipment between 10 am and 2 pm. Old Dominion will arrive with a lift gate, if necessary, or the freight line will deliver to the school's loading dock. The cost of shipping is included in the original printing agreement.

- 1 Sales Posters** provide an identifiable look that lets students, teachers and parents know that it's time to buy a yearbook. (Free in reasonable quantities for High Schools and Middle Schools; Elementary Schools may order posters on the original order form at 15 posters for \$4)
- 2 Campaign Signs** really grab parents' attention in the Kiss-and-Ride Line. (\$20 per set)
- 3 Vinyl Banners** can be hung anywhere students and parents gather. These weatherproof signs are a great way to promote the yearbook sale at the school's entrance. (\$35 per banner)
- 4 Yearbook Flair Buttons** are a fun and colorful way to promote the yearbook sale. Students will want to collect all the different designs. Pass these out to students as they buy the yearbook to help create excitement. (\$18 for an assorted pack of 100)

Reach out to students who don't expect to be in the yearbook and might not plan to buy. Customize the text and submit up to 80 photos to be printed on 20 different posters. (\$50 for 20 posters)
- 6 "YES, PLEASE!" Card** allows students to indicate that they are interested in buying a yearbook. Use these cards to collect information to create mailings home to parents. (Free in reasonable quantities for High Schools and Middle Schools)
- 7 "LAST CHANCE" Card** reminds students to buy a book. The blank side can be customized with pricing information. (Free in reasonable quantities for High Schools and Middle Schools)
